At our last bus worker's meeting, we divided up into pairs to practice soul-winning one-on-one with each other. We like to do this every few months, to keep our workers sharp, and to help train the newer workers.



My 12-13 yr-old boys' Sunday school class averages 15 boys each week. About 10 of them have accepted Christ and are baptized..



Pray for the salvation of Dasael, Don Henry, Margarita, and Reina, whom Abbi and I witnessed to this month on door-to-door outreach.

Honduras celebrates independence from Spain on September 15. That Sunday, while heading to church with a bus full of riders, the police completely shut down both lanes for parades, which was supposed to only be in one lane. While stuck on our school bus with no AC for two hours in traffic, we prayed, sang songs, and I preached a full message. We also gave tracts to the cars around us. Our first, full church service on wheels was an adventure, and it made us thankful for the beautiful building that we worship in normally.



A drunk driver hit my parents' car after church and flipped it completely upside down, bruising and scraping them both, totaling the car, and fracturing two of my mom's neck vertebrae. The drunk driver was never caught, but we just praise the Lord for sparing my parents' lives.



Abbi has taught several Bible college girls enough piano to now start playing in our midweek service.

We taught the 7-10 yr. olds in children's church this month, and averaged 60 kids weekly. On the last Sunday, I gave a simple gospel invitation, and about 15 children asked Jesus to forgive them and save them.



Over 40 teens ages 12-18 attended our youth meeting, and someone brought Little Caesar's pizza from the capital city. I preached on the importance of studying the Bible as a daily habit.



We enjoyed taking the Bible college students and Christian school teachers on a hike around some ancient gold mines along a waterfall.
